Job Title: Evening Shift Supervisor – Canning (Moy)

Reporting To: Shift Manager

Hours of work: Evening Shift (1:30pm - 10:00pm)

Job Purpose: Supervision of processes and employees on a busy automated production line as per company guidelines and objectives. Reporting and liaising with the Shift Manager on all aspects of control records, work practices and staff training.

Main Responsibilities:

- Take responsibility for all staff employed in the canning area on their shift.
- Encourage production operatives to meet or exceed production targets to improve output efficiency and support the delivery of the highest quality of products.
- Ensure that all products meet quality control standards (BRC / Customer specific requirements).
- Train new machine operators to the company standard and maintain their skills training regularly relating to all work instructions and safe work practices.
- Manage and monitor material wastage and waste reduction rework.
- Demonstrate a commitment to Health & Safety by working in a safe manner, role modelling safety behaviours, challenging unsafe practices, rectifying unsafe conditions, and escalating to other team members when support is needed.
- Understand and adhere to Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) and company standards of hygiene and PPE.
- Work as part of a team, playing an active part in team and business successes. Engage with the daily challenges and opportunities and work effectively with others to overcome any issues.
